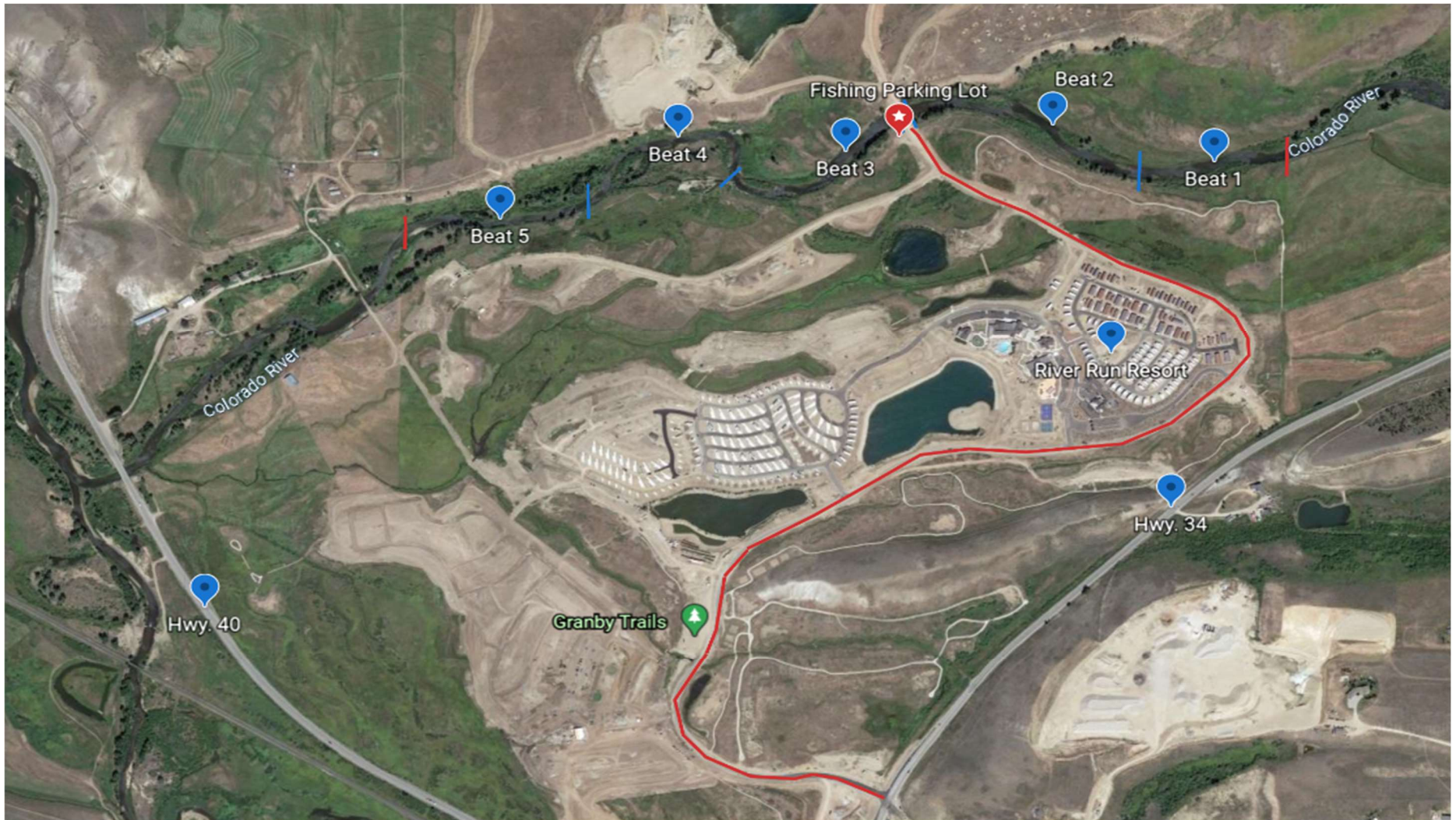


Granby Trails (Sun Outdoors Rocky Mountains Resort) Colorado River Fishing Beats



Beat 1 – This beat runs from the upstream river boundary to the downstream Beat 2 sign. Cross where it is safe to walk. Fishing is best on the west side of the river.

Beat 2 – Beat 2 runs from the Beat 2 sign to the downstream bridge. Both sides of the river are fishable, but access the river from the west side of the bridge to avoid any construction work areas and the intake box.

Beat 3 – This beat starts on the downstream side of the bridge and runs to the Beat 4 sign. For the first part of this beat, the best walking is from the west side. After the willows, both sides are fishable. The last pool before Beat 4 is deep and above your waders (at low water) so you cannot walk across the water.

Beat 4 – This beat starts at the Beat 4 sign and runs downstream, to just past the island to the Beat 5 sign. For easier fishing, walk on the east side of this beat.

Beat 5 – Beat 5 starts at the Beat 5 sign and runs downstream, to the property line with a “do not enter” sign. For this beat, you should be a competent caster since there are a lot more trees along the bank. For easier fishing access, walking is the best on the east side of the river.
